##### THE PSALM 95 MODEL

#### I. APPRECIATE THE MANY MOODS OF WORSHIP

1. Joy (1-5)
2. Reverence (6,7b)
3. Obedience (7c-11)

#### II. FOCUS ON THE ONE OBJECT OF OUR WORSHIP

1. The Lord God
  - Yahweh (1)
  - Rock of our Salvation (2)
  - Great God (3)
  - Creator/Sustainer (4,5)
  - Creator/Maker (6)
  - Provider/Protector (7)

#### III. PRACTICE THE MANY EXPRESSIONS OF WORSHIP

1. Voices raised (1,2)
2. Knees bowed (6)
3. Ears listening (7c)
4. Wills obeying (8-10)
5. Hands demonstrating (Psa. 28:2; Psa. 47:1)
6. Instruments leading (Psa. 150)
